Glimpses of Jodhpur Conclave 2006 - Journey Forward

Sri O.P. Bhatt ji took over as Chairman of SBI in June 2006, and G D Nadaf as General Secretary of AISBOF on 17th July 2006. At that time, the Bank's market share dropped from 24% to 17% due to the entry of new generation private sector banks.

2. During our informal discussions with the Chairman, both the Federations suggested a brainstorming session with Top Management and top office bearers from all the Circles, to chalk in an action plan to address the crisis. The Federations assured him that there would be no discussion on monetary issues during the session. The only issue to be churned is how to face the challenges.

3. Consequently, a three-day Jodhpur Conclave was held at Hotel Umedh Palace between 15th and 17th December 2006. The General Secretaries of both the Staff Unions and Officers Associations from 14 Circles and DMDs and above from the Top Management participated, along with the McKinsey HR Constituents team.

4. During the conclave, All India State Bank Officers Federation made a PowerPoint presentation, which reflected the feelings and suggestions of grassroots-level staff, emphasizing the need to improve upward communication and encourage staff participation through programs like "Pariwartan."

A Joint Declaration was also issued, boosting the operational level staff's morale and encouraging them to be part of Bank budgets. The New Indian Express carried an article on the Conclave titled "Elephant is Dancing", linking it to SBI's progress.
